

A UK first coming to Worcester 19th-27th July

WIFYS, the UK's first-ever non-competitive international youth singing festival, comes to Worcester this summer. Organised by **Sing UK** in association with the **European Choral Association - Europa Cantat (ECA-EC)**, the city will play host to 11 choirs from 10 different countries - Belgium, Poland, Spain, the Czech Republic, Austria, Russia, Hong Kong, Germany, Lithuania - and the UK. Street singing, concerts in Worcester city and around the county, singing at church services and a Welcome Concert will delight singers and audiences. The climax will be the final night's **Gala Concert** in Worcester's magnificent cathedral, with all four of the week's distinguished international conductors, directing the young singers in performance. The programme will include the **World Premiere** of a specially commissioned work from UK composer **Bob Chilcott** (*Five Days that Changed the World* with words by Charles Bennett), which will be conducted by the composer - and will involve all 400 young singers! *With the festival being the first event of its kind in the UK, they have taken as their theme, 'Peace & Unity between Nations', to reaffirm the continuing mission of ECA-EC, and their own shared aspirations - to work towards a more peaceful world through the engagement of young people from different nations coming together to sing.
