#### A privilege and a responsibility.

On 20th April we will be having our Annual General Meeting (AGM) at which we have the opportunity to elect the District Church Council). (DCC) The DCC members are elected

- 1. to help Gary with the mission of the church in our area of the parish
- 2. to make sure the Parish Share is paid along with other bills (gas / insurance etc..)and to decide how money is to be spent on other things.
- 3. to make sure the church buildings are well maintained. These are the legal requirements.

At St. John's the DCC has always been about more than that and we spend a great deal of our time discussing how to help the church grow spiritually in all age groups, grow together as a family and reach out to the community around us.

Do read the reports which will be issued before the AGM and see just how much goes on at St.John's and for which the DCC has responsibility. You can see that DCC members need to be chosen with care and prayed for regularly.

DCC members are elected for 3 years, which can be extended to a maximum of 6 years. Those who are elected to the Parochial Church Council are automatically (ex - officio) on the DCC as are LLMs Readers)
