Thought for the week

As we come to worship together today in St John's, it's worth remembering that we all come (I hope) to encounter the God who loves us and cares for us 24/7. It doesn't matter particularly what our own tradition is, high/low/somewhere in the middle. What does matter to God is that we prayerfully and humbly acknowledge our complete need of him, and that we come with open spirits in order to give our whole selves to him. Only then can we properly receive from him that which he needs to say to us. (Read Isaiah 6, for e.g.)

He reveals himself, and we respond, because he made us to be in relationship with him at a very deep level. In other words, as Martin Luther once said: 'To know God is to worship him.' He makes himself known in several ways: through his creation, his written word, and, supremely, through Jesus and the sending of the Spirit.

Some people like to have a liturgy to worship by; others prefer a freer, more spontaneous expression, but I believe that the heart of worship is a genuine encounter with the living God, through his Son, Jesus Christ, in the power of the Holy Spirit. It is not so much the form of worship, but God's presence that transforms worship into something very special that even the best of human words cannot express.

Worship involves the whole of our lives, so continue to be in that special place as you go into the week ahead!
