Sent on behalf of Revd Ian Spencer, Warden, Holland House, Cropthorne I am writing to you to introduce myself and Holland House.

You may already be aware of us and what we do, but if not, we are a Christian Retreat House, based in Cropthorne, with a national status but largely serving the Diocese of Worcester and surrounding dioceses, which offers quiet spaces for reflection, prayer and contemplation, together with beautiful gardens, delicious food and warm hospitality. I would like to draw your attention to our Anniversary Appeal which is aiming to raise in excess of £100,000. Before launching the Appeal we have already raised £30,000. Since then largely due to The Friends of Holland House, but also individual gifts, trust donation pledges over three years, and actual gifts received, that figure has risen to over £60,000. As custodians of a fine historic building we are constantly faced with new challenges and have recently received a notice from the Fire Officer requiring additional unplanned expenditure, emphasising again the need for the Appeal to be a success. I hope your parish will feel able to support it. We look forward to welcoming the members of your church to Holland House during 2017.
