

Yesterday Abi and I had the opportunity to go to Compton Verney, a glorious estate in Warwickshire. The purpose of our visit was to see exhibitions including 'The Lost Words' - an amazing combination of poetry and pictures focusing on nature, and 'Inside Stories' by Quentin Blake - in which he shared the journey from rough outline to finished sketches for some of his most well known illustrations. We also visited the Textile Fair and marvelled at talents of the artists who were exhibiting, which included skills such as intricate embroidery, felting, fabric printing, mixed media and knitting.
