Dear all,

Listening to God is a large part of our Christian walk. For the most part this forms the second portion of our conversation with God. We share and He hears us, then He speaks and we listen to what He is saying to us. Our prayer life changes us as we hear God's voice and pay heed to it. What we do and say needs to be moulded and formed by the voice of God.

In Luke 2:22-40 we hear how both Simeon and Anna heard God's Spirit nudge them when Jesus is brought into the temple by His parents, and they then spoke out those wonderful words we read in the Gospel passage. The reason they recognised Jesus was because they had made a habit of listening to God in their everyday life.

We need to make a habit of listening to God. In ministry I find that it can become so easy to allow our devotional life to become mechanical and hence lifeless and I know this is as true for those not in ministry. However when we spend time with God and listen to His voice, these can be dynamic moments and our devotional life become vibrant and rich. It is out of this rich relationship that we are able to speak out In praise to God for His greatness. We are able to declare the wonders of God. It is out of knowing God in our devotional

life that we are able to speak out about Jesus. This is where our confidence lies and where we grow in our Christian walk.
