We start differently this morning, as together we come to worship and thank God for the week we have had and to confess anything we need to say sorry for.

During Holy Week, Bishop John gave a sermon at Worcester Cathedral (a copy of which is available on the board in the foyer) an extract of the sermon is below:

'Being with is the business of the persons of the Trinity, being with one another, and enjoying and delighting in one another. Being with is at the heart of the Christian faith, if the word 'Emmanuel' is to be taken seriously. 'Look the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and they shall call him Emmanuel, which means 'God with us'. If 'with' is at the heart of God and at the heart of the faith it should surely lie at the heart of ministry and mission, too.

Jesus tells his disciples that he is among them, among them as one who serves. But that is not the end of the matter. He goes on to tell them that, having stood by him in his trials, his disciples will have bestowed on them a kingdom, so that they might eat and drink at his table in his kingdom, and sit on thrones. Their destiny is to be with Jesus and with one another in glory.

That is our destiny, too. It is therefore our responsibility to become accustomed to being with Jesus now - in prayer - and to being with one another.....
