"Dear all,

I want to take the opportunity to say "Thank You," to all those who have sent me cards, letter, emails and phone calls following the AGM in April, and for the minute which the AGM agreed on after I left. I truly appreciate the prayers, love and support that each of you have expressed in these cards and messages. Without sounding pompous about it, I am your shepherd.
