In Romans 8 we have a passage that is rich in a way that far exceeds what we could ever imagine. It speaks of the work of the Holy Spirit in the life of a believer. Jesus had used the analogy of the wind to drive home his point concerning the invisible yet undeniable work of the Holy Spirit. In that analogy we are confronted with the fact that despite the reality that we cannot know the where - abouts of the wind its effect is plain to everyone. The Holy Spirit works in the same way! We may not exactly understand how the Holy Spirit works, but we can see the effect of His work.

Romans 8 points to the work of the Holy Spirit, who though invisible yet is undeniably working in a person's life. Like the wind, the Holy Spirit is invisible to our naked eyes. Like the wind, the Holy Spirit works in ways we do not know and see. Nevertheless, like the wind though unseen but we hear its sound; the work of the Holy Spirit may be hidden the results are visible.

The Holy Spirit works in our lives to produce new life, and the gifts and the fruit of the Holy Spirit. The blessings (the beatitudes) follow, as we allow Him the freedom to work in us.

But the life in obedience to the Holy Spirit brings life and peace (v. 6). The indwelling of the Holy Spirit in our lives provides us with power necessary to live a righteous life. It is our responsibility to listen and carry out the prompting of the Holy Spirit.
