"There is no fear in love. But perfect love drives out fear,..." 1 John 4:18

John the evangelist writes about the love of God. And among the many statements he makes lies snuggled this one. How easy is it for us to be fearful?

When things go wrong, when we are faced with difficult decisions, when we face an uncertain future, when waiting for news from the doctor, it is so easy to give in to fear.

God's love is perfect. Because as John tells us earlier in the chapter "God is love." Vs 16a. So because God is perfect in every way, His love is perfect in every way.

John then completes the sentence with " ...whoever lives in love lives in God, and God in them." Vs 16b. If we live our lives out in the love of God, where every decision, every action and every word is committed in the light of His presence, then we experience every day that perfect love of God, and are assured of the presence of God even in the hard and rough and dry places we sometimes find ourselves wandering in.
