Since the beginning of this year, I have had a real sense of God wanting to do a new thing in our parish. Then over the last couple of month's, ever since Easter, as a parish we have all been looking at the working of the Holy Spirit in the Church. When the Holy Spirit works it always results in mission and service, and this inevitably leads to Church growth. Out of prayer and seeking God's will the three churches in the parish are going to undertake new ventures in the autumn.

Here at St Peter's we will be starting a Healing Service. It is as it tells you on the box. It is a service distinct from a regular Sunday service that offers the ministry of healing prayer to those who are sick or suffering in body, mind or spirit. I believe in a God who heals. In fact His name is Jehovah Raphe, the God who heals.

Jesus commanded His disciples to go and heal the sick, and I believe this command is as true for us today as it was for the early disciples. As they prayed the sick were healed, the broken mended and made whole. The same Holy Spirit is at work in us today, so why will He not heal?

I need your help. Firstly, to pray for us, for the whole ministry team taking part, for those the Lord will touch through this ministry. Secondly, bring in those who are sick like the men in Jesus time. There are those who need a healing touch of the Lord among friends, family and neighbours. Bring them with you as you come. Research shows that people will come if brought along, but many will not come if expected to come on their own.

Jesus looked and the crowds and was filled with compassion. He saw them as sheep without a shepherd. He said to His disciples, "Pray therefore..." I ask you today, "Pray therefore..."
